The impact of the Vital Toronto Fund is significant. Since 2004, it has had a collective impact on 372 of Toronto's best organizations by investing close to \$5.68 million in:



Vital Ideas

Support strategic activities to take community organizations to the next level through the Vital Ideas grant program.

 We have invested over \$3.49 million in 136 high-impact organizations to stabilize, expand, or replicate initiatives improving Toronto's quality of life;



Vital People

Strengthen leadership through the Vital People grant program.

• We have invested more than \$445,000 in the professional development of 93 of Toronto's exceptional not-for-profit leaders; and




Vital Youth
